2. Dog Tag- All dogs must be registered annually with the Village Clerk and have a current Village Dog Tag.
3. Fowl & Rabbits Require a Permit at the Clerk's Office. Info
4. Register Your Business or Home-Based Business.
5. Advertise on the Village Marquee (**Currently Unavailable**) & Website.
6. Rent the Village Hall with Kitchen for your events.
7. Reserve the Schneider Park Large or Small Pavilion.
8. Notary (**We currently do not have a Notary on Site**)
9. Voter Registration
10. Our Current Website is <https://brightonil.com> . You can check the website for Calendar Events, Pay Your Water Bill, Print Forms, check out Garage Sales, and sign up for notifications. Call the Clerk to be placed on the Garage Sale Map (when we have the yearly City Wide sale)
11. Facebook=Village of Brighton (See Above)
12. Non-Highway Vehicle (UTV) Applications (You must obtain a sticker to ride your UTV in town).
13. Unlicensed and/or Inoperable Vehicles may only remain on the property for 7 days.
14. Yards must be kept free of debris. Burning is not allowed in any street or roadway, on windy days and completed by 6:00pm.
15. A designated area in Betsy Ann Park is for Village Resident's ONLY to place limbs, brush, and leaves.
16. You must have an Illinois Fishing License to Fish in the Schneider Park Lake. Please keep our parks clean and family friendly.
17. Farmer's Market is on Thursdays throughout the summer at Schneider Park from 4:00pm-7:00pm
