A Special meeting was held on February 23, 1981 at 7:00p.m.
Meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. By Mayor Ahlemeyer.

Present: Carr, Birk, Markwardt, Cravens Wild
Absent: Wittman

The purpose of this meeting was:

1. To employ full time police officer and to establish salary.
2. To employ part time dispatcher.
3. To discuss with Betsey Ann Association the disposition of the fire equipment to the Fire District.

The recommendation from the Police Committee to employ Brad Bott as part time dispatcher. Birk made motion to employ Brad Bott, seconded by Carr. Roll call vote approved.

The committee also recommended the employment of Jerome Wooldridge as full time police officer. Wild made motion to employ Jerome Wooldridge as full time police officer, seconded by Cravens. Roll call vote approved.

The committee recommended the starting salary for police officer to be 1025.00 dollars per month, Markwardt made motion salary be 1025.00 dollars per month, seconded by Wild. Roll call vote approved.

Attorney Watson was here to discuss the legal possibilities of giving the fire equipment to the Fire District. He stated the Village could not give the fire equipment to them, but would have to receive adequate consideration for the property. He stated there were several possibilities that could be worked out. He will receive a letter from Illinois Municipal League attorney confirming what he has told us. After a lengthy discussion, it was decided that the property in question needed to be appraised then the Village could proceed from there.

The clerk was instructed to contact Towers Fire Apparatus for an appraisal of the fire truck.

Carr made motion to adjourn, seconded by Markwardt, Meeting was adjourned at 7:55 pm.
