Bidders had been invited to the meeting of answer International Harvester and Sunderland were reprequestions. sented by Limon Fleming and Mr. Mathis. Bob Birk went over bid sheets and read total bids as follows: Internation Harvester. \$14,533.77 without trade, 14,000.00 with trade. Limon Fleming stated that power brakes were standard equipment on this truck. Electric lift is something new, he stated. Truck alone would be \$9,413.00 without snow plow and spreader. He has two trucks in stock if we do not want one that was bid. Sunderland's truck 1978 model withbid did not meet specifications, 1977 model. out plow and spreader would be \$9.759.30. Deliveryldate could be 60-90 days. International Harvester truck would be delivered Roberts Ford truck was \$10.834.57 without spreader Mr. Mathis also explained that he has truck in strek and plow. with small varianes. International does not build 350 engine. Bob Birk stated that 276 increased horsepower and heavy duty cooling should be on truck. Under coating should also be included. Mr. Fleming stated that there could be included at a final bid price of \$9,736.59 plus trade-in of old truck. we decide to kkep old truck, price adjustment will be increased to \$500.00 over that figure. Harris Carr made motion to purchase truck from International Harvester as bid plus heavy duty cooling, larger engine and undercoating for \$9,736.59 with trade and option to keep old truck if desired. Bob Birk seconded motion. Roll call vote passed unanimously.
