Motion was made by Ken Markwardt to pay bills as read by the clerk. Don Little seconded motion. Roll call vote, passed unanimously.

Secondreading of ordinance no. 395, regulating parking, was read by the clerk. Don Little made a motion that secondreading of ordinance no. 395 be accepted as read. Harris Carr seconded motion. Roll call vote, passed unanimously.

Charles Sheppard gave his recommendations for items to be included on FHA grant application. Three major items were:

1. 10" main from the north end of Storyland to a connection with tank on highway #11.
2. 6" main from Sunny Aire to Markwt and past city limits.
3. Brighton-Bunker Hill road to Market Street.

Belmont Scheffel stated that updating should be considered from Palmer to George, Vine to Oak, Anna to Jersey, Walnut to South and Cross to Brown. Grant should include lab equipment necessary for use with new facilities and street repairs to streets destructed during this process. Total cost would be about \$2,000,000.00. Ken Markwardt made motion to accept Water Board and Engineer's reports for recommendations on grant applications with engineer to begin preliminary work. Harris Carr seconded motion. Roll call vote, passed unanimously. Charles Sheppard to give monthly report.

Jerome Wooldridge moved to adjourn. Ken Markwardt seconded. Voice vote, passed unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
