The Mayor and several board members went to Springfield, Dec 9th 1965, hearing report on Ill. Commerce Commission, 1 copy of Transcript learning of Ill. Commerce Commission was purchased.

An order of 43 lengths of 20 or 21 ft. lengths of 2" reject galvanized pipe was sent to N.O. Nelson, 1700 E. Broadway, Alton, Ill.
