June 6, 1966

The regular meeting of the Village Board was called to order by Mayor Ahlemeyer at 7:00 P. M. in Village Hall.

Clerk called roll of trustees:

Absent: None

Minutes of meeting of May 2 were read. Jones made motion they be accepted. Lucker seconded.

Voice vote - carried.

Treasurer asked that check be written to First National Bank of Chicago for \$142.50 interest, plus \$10.00 service. Tuey made motion Board pass resolution this go on record. Hughes seconded.

Voice vote - carried.

Jones made motion bills be paid and charged to proper account. Scheffel seconded. Roll call vote - carried

Mayor introduced Atty. Quinn.

Abraham stated bids on arterial street work would be read 3 P. M. June 13.

Abraham recommended angle parking on north side of North St. by Cal's Market, with no parking on south side.

Mr. Koenig of Sunnyaire questioned street structure in this subdivision. Was advised they were up to specifications.

Wilson mentioned bad bump on Margaret St. at entrance to Twin Acres.

Clerk is to write Pearly Hanold requesting weeds be cut at Cottage Hotel.

Septic tanks at Sunnyaire are draining into ditch. A committee of Scheffel, Lucker and ~~Jones~~ ^{Hughes} to check this.

Atty. Quinn will write Lloyd Wells requesting he put a culvert at entrance to his place on Brown Street.

Kenny Noble, Macoupon Co. dog catcher was introduced. Dogs not wearing rabies vaccination tags are subject to pick-up.

The following changes were recommended in street lighting:

Change all 2500 lumen lights to 4000 lumen.

The 4 - 2500 lumen on S. Main at corners of East, Brown, Plum and Park Drive moved to -

1 at Vine and Market - 1 at Vine and Burlington, one at Charles and S. Main and 1 at Ruth and Anna Sts. The 4 lights removed on S. Main to be replaced with 20,000 lumen mercury vapors. Cost quoted by Mr. Bivins of Illinois Power Co. - \$183.89 and we will have one additional 4,000 lumen to place at any desired location. This will run approximately \$2200 per year, and includes the above plus necessary new fixtures, etc. Wilson moved we accept as Mr. Bivins read - Scheffel seconded. 1st reading. Roll call vote - carried.

Clerk read Ord. #301 amending Ord. #145 regarding parking. Wilson made motion to suspend rules so ordinance could be passed at once. Jones seconded. Roll call vote - carried.

Hughes made motion to adopt ordinance - Lucker seconded. Roll call vote - carried.

Clerk read first reading Ord. #302 amending Ord. #271 regarding increase in water connection charges approximately 33%. They made motion to suspend the rules and pass ordinance at once - Scheffel seconded. Roll call vote - carried.

Lucker made motion to accept Ord. #302 - They seconded. Roll call vote - carried.

Regarding appropriations Ord. #300, Hughes made motion to suspend rules and pass at once. Lucker seconded. Roll call vote - carried.

Scheffel made motion ordinance be adopted. Jones seconded. Roll call vote - carried. Clerk to have published one time in Area News.

Clerk made first reading of Ordinance regarding tax on cigarette vending machines, etc.

Clerk made first reading Ordinance regarding tax on amusement devices.

Attorney is handling R&R Construction business.

Correspondence was read by clerk. MFT allotment - \$790.31 - Municipal tax - \$436.97. Jones made motion correspondence be accepted. Lucker seconded. Voice vote - carried.

Lucker made motion a charge of \$15.00 per year round for use of city hall, except for non-profit groups who should clean up after using hall free. Hughes seconded.

Voice vote - carried.
