As Ted Shakofsky asked for this meeting to be called, he will pay the trustees.

Shakofsky's purpose for the meeting was to request the Village to black-top our end of street into his subdivision. He stated as follows:

He will blade street and if any more rock is needed, he will put it on. This will cost \$1.24 per yard if it can be done when he does his part. The total cost \$1100.00 for 960 sq. yds. or a little over 300'. Shakofsky to do 517 sq. yds. of his own black-topping. He will rock the whole works, but just blacktop to circle. He stated that the Village owes him \$287.00 for the front end where he put culvert in.

Village has made no appropriations for this work.

Scheffel made motion to not black-top this year. Tuey seconded.

Roll call vote - carried.

Jones made motion to adjourn. Lucker seconded. Voice vote - carried.
