Clerk called roll of trustees.

Minutes of meeting of November 7 were read. After corrections, Tuey made motion to accept. Hughes seconded.

Hughes made motion to accept and charge to proper accounts. Scheffel seconded.

Roll call vote - carried.

Mayor had a request for a street light on North Street. Hughes and Lucker to check location. This light to be free.

Tom Beckham, Sr. asked permission to construct a 40 x 100' all metal warehouse building west of Brighton Lumber Co. to extend approximately to Olive St. and to have a driveway thru it, opening on west end. This building to be used primarily for lumber storage. Hughes made motion to give permission for him to proceed as explained. Tuey seconded.

Voice vote - carried.

Curb and gutter for North St. was discussed. Abraham suggested drawing up plans and if there is enough money after taking care of Main and Center Streets, this could be taken care of at the same time. Cost is approximately \$19,00 per running foot.

Correspondence was read by clerk. Motor fuel tax allotment, \$738.55 - Municipal tax - \$1018.20. Lueker made motion to accept. Hughes seconded. Voice vote - carried.

Trial between Village of Brighton and Reek Construction Company to be January 12, 1966. Scheffel, Abraham and Ahlemeyer will have to be present.

Wilson mentioned culvert on Market St. needs 3' extension.

Farmer to remove snow from streets this winter.

Attorney Bassett to draw ordinance for raise in pay for Mayor and Trustees. He is also to add an amendment to ordinance #186 limiting hours to from 9 A. M. to 6 P. M. for door to door salesmen and peddlers.

Regarding streets at Sunnyside, Beckham to maintain for one year from date black top was laid.

Next meeting to be January 3.

Lueker made motion to adjourn. Scheffel seconded.
