March 6, 1967

The regular meeting of the Village Board was called to order by Mayor Ahlemeyer at 7:00 P. M. in Village Hall.

Clerk called roll of trustees:

Present: Wilson, Tuey, Scheffel, Lucker, Hughes, Jones

Absent: None

Minutes of meeting of February 6 read. Wilson made motion to accept. Hughes seconded. Voice vote - carried.

Due to illness of B. F. Towse, Clerk read the following Treasurer's Report; of Feb. 28, 1967:

Lucker made motion to accept. Tuey seconded. Voice vote - carried.

Lucker made motion to accept and incorporate in minutes. Jones seconded. Voice vote - carried.

Chase reported he had ordered another pump. A new typewriter has been bought for the office.

Adrian Smith reported 14 arrests - \$265.00 fines for February.

Scheffel made motion to accept report. Jones seconded.

Voice vote - carried.

Proper installation of culverts was discussed. Tabled for next meeting.

Herman Schneider reported a bad hole in front of village hall. Mayberry to ^{CORRECT} care for this.

Clerk ordered to have ballots printed. Each Board Member to choose one judge by next meeting.

Complaint read from Robert Schoeberle against Wm. Gerdes for using firearms in village. Attorney to write Gerdes.

Cal Vonnehman reported for Civil Defense. 6 members attended C. D. class. He mentioned dangers of anhydrous ammonia being stored close to village. A picture ^{DEVIATING THE DANGER} regarding this will be shown Tuesday, Feb. 4, 7:30 P. M. at Legion Hall. Hughes made motion to accept.

Tuey seconded. Voice vote - carried.

Abraham explained letter of Feb. 20 regarding soil survey which will have to be made before paving Center and Main Sts. This is required by State Highway Commission because of use of MFT funds. Each road to have separate tests to determine requirements of base. Scheffel made motion to go ahead with tests. Jones seconded. Voice vote - carried. Abraham to find out how fee is to be paid and to see if borings can be made on North St. at same time.

Roll call vote - carried.

Correspondence read by clerk. Municipal tax \$702.18, MFT - \$909.69. Jones made motion to accept. Hughes seconded. Voice vote - carried.

Village Board went on record as instructing Chief of Police to contact each individual and give them 48 hours to purchase delinquent vehicle stickers, and if not purchased after this time, a ticket will be issued.

Each trustee is to give name of a citizen of Brighton to serve on an "over all traffic problem committee. Hughes names Robert Schoeberle - Lucker named Marvin Powerl. Others to have names at next meeting.

One 4000 lumen light is due village. Wilson made motion to follow recommendation and have light put on Cindy Street. Scheffel seconded.

Voice vote - carried.

Clerk to write Bivins regarding this.

They mentioned speed of trains going through Brighton. Hughes mentioned bells are now loud enough. Board went on record as wanting bells turned up and speed checked. Clerk to write GM&O.

Board went on record magazine soliciting in Brighton, except for local or known ^{placed resolution} salesmen. ^{as refusing all}

Scheffel mentioned that a band from Granite City had wanted to rent Village Hall for dances on Friday nights - he refused them. Hughes made motion to uphold Scheffel's decision. Lucker seconded.

Voice vote - carried.

Lucker made motion to adjourn. Jones seconded. Voice vote - carried.
