Sewer System report Hughes seconded. Tuey made motion to accept and incorporate in minutes. Voice vote - carried.

Adrian Smith reported 4 arrests in March - fines not received. 17 personal contacts regarding delinquent wheel tax - 9 have paid to date. Lucker made motion to accept report. Tuey seconded. Voice vote - carried.

Adrian showed map of where 25 mile speed limit signs are needed. Forrest Healey and Randy Childress will erect signs.

Trustees have chosen the following to constitute a Planning Committee to attend meeting to be held April 19: ^{BPS} Schoeberle, Marvin Powell, Ray Heideman, Cal Vonnehman and Gene Urban.

Am't { Cal mentioned a new fire engine would be needed in a few years. Asked if \$1000 or \$1500 per year could be put away for this purpose. Attorney advised against it.

They made motion to adjourn. Hughes seconded. Voice vote - carried.
