Wilson made motion to adopt ordinance #308 as read. Hughes seconded. Voice vote - carried.

Mayor explained Planning Committee. They will serve until it is felt their purpose has been fulfilled. Members to meet and make recommendations to Village Board regarding improvements needed in village. Gene Orban was appointed chairman of group. First meeting to be after Village Board May meeting.

Tuey made motion to adjourn. Lucker seconded. Voice vote - carried.
