- 2. Roll Call: Mayor Schafer called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Roll Call, Chris Dawdy-Y, Bill Oertel-Y, Fred Benz-Y, Ed Jacoby-Y, Mike Roberts-Y, Jamie Boyd-Y. Also in attendance were Chief Levertt, Clerk Billie Laubscher, Treasurer Kirsten Blackorby, Attorney Robert Watson,
- 3. Review Minutes and Approve: Mike Roberts made a motion to accept the minutes and place them on file, 2nd by Jamie. Voice Vote, All ayes, no nays, Motion Carried.
- 4. Treasurers Report: Ed made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report. 2nd by Chris. Voice Vote, All ayes, no nays, Motion Carried
- 5. Bills: Oertel made a motion to accept the bills and charge to the appropriate accounts, 2nd by Ed Jacoby. Roll Call, All ayes, no nays, Motion Carried.
- 6. Hours by Employees: Dawdy made a motion to accept the hours by employees, 2nd by Boyd. Voice Vote, All ayes, no nays, Motion Carried
- 7. Audience Comment:
 - a. Eleanor Hindley stated that the Zoning Board Meeting last meeting was illegal, not a quorum. She counts 8 names. Mayor explained that there are 7 members and the 8th is the Zoning Inspector. He is not a voting member on the Zoning Board. Therefore 4 out of 7 members present, does make a quorum. Mrs. Hindley has asked that no junk buildings be built across from her property on W. Center. Discussion was held regarding that the Public Hearing re-zoning meeting on April 22, 2014 that she attended was only about Re-zoning from A1-B1. Not about any buildings at this time. All buildings that are built must go thru Zoning Board Committee first. The Village is working hard on cleaning properties up. There is a Planning Commission Committee in place to plan the future of Village of Brighton business district. The Board is working on changing Ordinances to better serve the community. The Board is moving in some good directions. The Board is working on all grants that apply. Village is in process of working on a grant of over 1.6 million to replace water lines which were placed in 1951. The Board and Committees work very hard on trying to get everything done in town.
 - b. Mobile Street Resident stated that Palmer corner has increased traffic going fairly fast around that corner. He does not feet that we should stop the parking along side of street, that this will only increase the speed of traffic. Joe Harris stated that there's an ordinance on books that says 18 feet must be between the vehicles. If cars are parked on both sides of the street, then 2 cars cannot pass in between.
 - c. Carolyn Kelly asks if any building is built on W. Center, that neighbors will be notified. Mayor stated that all building permits go thru Zoning Board then Board Meeting
 - d. Eleanor asks how they are going to get to their homes. Contractor will have to route traffic, but will try to accommodate all residents on W. Center with access in and out of property,

however, under construction there may be times of inconvenience. Mayor states that sidewalks and road widening will make this a better road. The driveways have been photographed to help contractors put back driveways as they were found.

- 5) Public Safety Committee April 21, 2014 Meeting, Chairman Ed Jacoby read the minutes.
 - a. Recognition of Public Service
 - b. Chief Levertt discussed receiving 2 calls on the parking in Georgene Acres. He measured about 17'8" from front bumper of car to curb which was offset from another vehicle. He feels that painting anything to prohibit parking would not do any good for the

neighborhood, that by knocking on doors would be a much better way to address this situation, rather than pitting neighbor against neighbor. He went to fire dept. and got their biggest fire truck and took to this area. At that time a larger vehicle was parked there than when initial the complaint came in. Even with larger vehicle parked there, the roadway can accommodate an emergency vehicle going thru. He provided pictures of a fire truck going thru that area with cars parked on both sides. He feels at this point by working with all neighbors, this would better serve the community. Mayor agrees with Chief that by handling the issue by knocking and talking would be better than ticketing. We need to collectively work together as citizens in this community and work thru it. Roberts suggest we look at all ordinances on books. Mayor says all ordinances in this town are being upheld by knock and talk first. If there are ordinances that need to be changed, bring thru the committee's and present to Board.

c. Roberts asked where Police Dept. is on getting computers in cars. Chief stated that the State contract is with Verizon which he has a meeting set up with Verizon Tuesday, May 08, 2014 to discuss their Mobility cards. Jamie Boyd suggested if we have anyone that wishes to donate, this is exactly what this Village needs. Dawdy suggested a Windows Tablet instead of iPads or laptops.
