ROLL CALL VOTE:

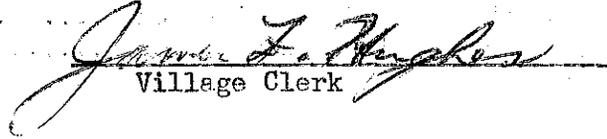
YEAS: Scheffel, Powell, Schoeberle, Vonnahmen, Kamp.

Village Clerk

Streets to have 6" of rock, 20' wide.

All culverts must be approved for length and diameter by the village street committee.

Ditches must be a minimum of 12" to whatever necessary to drain.

Expense of first application of rock and oil to be borne by subdivider.

The first application of rock must be of $1\frac{1}{2}$ " size and balance must be of $\frac{3}{4}$ " size.

Streets should have a crown of approx. 12" when finished.
