Kamp moved and Vonnahmen seconded the motion to rescind motion made in the Oct. 3rd meeting which read as follows: "Kamp moved and Schoeberle seconded the motion to place the village hall up for sale by sealed bids. The village has the right to accept or reject any or all bids. The bids must be in by 7p.m. Nov 7th 1960. The sale of the village hall is to be advertised in the Alton Evening Telegraph and the Gillespie News Oct. 10th, 17th and 24th." Motion carried.
