The special meeting was called to meet with a committee representing the water customers outside the corporate limits of Village of Brighton, who protested the raise of minimum rates on water outside of Village. Marvin Bott, John Storey, Oliver Schroeder and Harley Conrad of the committee were present.

President H. G. Bott gave the reasons for the raise:

- a) Out of town water customers did not carry tax load to retire the General Obligation Bonds.
- b) Need of another stand pipe and tank with the probable increase of customers.
- c) Possibility of Personal Tax in Madison Co. on water main.

Marvin Bott stated that he didn't really have a complaint outside of feeling the raise being too much and not having notified customers till the increased bills were sent out.

John Storey representing Tremont Addition said majority of that addition 178 houses would be on minimum rate. He said \$3.50 minimum would have been more fair.

Harley Conrad and Oliver Schroeder held that on their line pressure was always low.

The committee, after giving their views, suggested that the Village Board take the problem under advisement.

Motion by Trustee Vonnahmen that Water Superintendent and City Engineer consult with Alton Water Co. to get a written determination of territory boundary and to insure ample water supply, seconded by Emery Kamp.
