VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, ILL. WATER LINE RE-LOCATION NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton, Illinois will receive bids until 8:00 P.M. May 14, 1962, for re-location of an existing 6" cast iron water supply line, in and along the Old Alton-Brighton Road, sometimes called North Humbert Road and also designated as County Highway 12A, between the Godfrey-Fosterburg Road and the Mason School.

Proposals on forms furnished with the Plans and Specifications must be filed in the office of the Village Clerk, Brighton, Ill., on or before the time and date above, at which time they will be opened and read. Proposal forms shall not be detached from the Contract Documents.

The work consists of furnishing and laying a new 6" cast iron water line along the East side of the Alton-Brighton Road, within the limits aforesaid, and connecting the same to the existing 6" water line along said road. Also, moving 9 meter installations and connecting them to the new water line, and necessary incidental work thereto.

A Bid Bond in the form of a cashier's check or corporate surety bond, and in the amount of 10% of the amount of the bid, must accompany each bid.

Proposal shall be in accordance with the General Conditions, Plans and Specifications as prepared by C. F. Abraham, Consulting Engineer of 544 East Broadway, Alton, Ill., which may be obtained at that address or at the office of the Village Clerk, Brighton, Ill.
