St. Cin.

Resolution A-62-3 read by Clerk, accepting water mains in Woodgate Subdivision located in the East half of the Southeast quarter of Section 35, Township 7 North, Range 10 West of the third principal meridian, Jersey County, Illinois.

Motion by Trustee Kamp that the Resolution A-62-3 be passed and approved by the Village Board, seconded by R. Crowder.

Letter from Mrs. Evelyn Cardinal, Local Red Cross Chairman, was read and the Village Clerk was instructed to write to Mrs. Cardinal offering the use of Village Hall for Bloodmobile Visit July 10.

Glenview Subdivision No. 2 addition was discussed by Board. The original plat was not at hand so Clerk was instructed to return the plat maps.

Motion by Trustee Kamp that the addition be given provisional approval and acceptance of streets await the inspection of Street and Alley Committee at such time as all rock is on and first oil application, seconded by C. Vonnahmen.

Motion by Trustee Vonnahmen that Village Attorney write Mrs. Z. Tucker, John Stone and W. D. Gilworth in regard to their several properties which are in bad repair to make improvements or remove existing buildings, seconded by Emery Kamp.

Voice Vote Carried.



State Senator Bill Lyons had been called on by Village Board President H. G. Bott and Trustees Cal. Vonnahmen, Geo. St. Cin and R. Crowder. The Senator took them to Dep't. of Re-development and after introductions they were briefed by a man of that Agency who suggested the Board make application for a loan in view of our good financial record of water system. This Agency expects to have representatives at a special meeting of Board June 11, 1962. The Senator was present and gave the above resume' at the meeting.

White-Phillips Bonding Co. representative said they could possibly increase their original commitment as to the amount of Bonds. They were flying to Chicago that same night.

Motion by Trustee Geo. St. Cin that the meeting be adjourned, seconded by F. G. Scheffel.
