Motion by Trustee Vonnahmen that permission be granted to Brighton Merchants Soft Ball Team to install lights on Diamond #2, be placed on Village rates if sanctioned by Illinois Power Co., \$75.00 to be placed with the Water Board in escrow, then pay metered light bill as it becomes due with \$75.00 in escrow to pay the last bill of season, any difference being refunded or paid ~~to~~ by the Soft Ball organization, seconded by E. Kamp.
