ORDINANCE NUMBER 134

AN ORDINANCE providing for the Granting of License to certain businesses and occupations in the Village of Brighton in the Counties of Macoupin and Jersey, and State of Illinois.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, COUNTY OF MACOUPIN AND STATE OF ILLINOIS

SECTION ONE

It shall hereafter be unlawful within the corporate limits of the Village of Brighton to carry on or transact any business hereinafter mentioned without first obtaining from the Village Clerk of the Village of Brighton a license therefor.

SECTION TWO

The businesses, occupations and employments for which licenses

shall be required, together with the amount thereof, shall be as follows: that is to say:

Road or Tent Show, Two (\$2.00) Dollars per day or Five (\$5.00) per week.

Picture Shows, One (\$1.00) Dollar per night or Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per Year.

Soft Drink Distributors - Five (\$5.00) Dollars per year.

Bill Posters or Out Door Sign Advertisers, Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per Year.

Itinerant Merchants Two (\$2.00) Dollars per day or Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars per year.

Peddlers, Two (\$2.00) Dollars per day or Twenty (\$20.00) per year.

Medicine Venders. Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per year.

Wholesale Liquor Distributors Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per Year.

Wholesale Beer Distributors, Ten (\$10.00) Dollars per year.

Wholesale Trucks handling Bread, Meat, Vegetables and Merchandise Five (\$5.00) Dollars per year.

SECTION THREE

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.

SECTION FOUR

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and posting as required by law.
