ORDINANCE # 137

An Ordinance amending certain provisions of ordinance Number 134 for the granting of licenses to certain businesses and occupations in the Village of Brighton.

Be it ordained that section two of Ordinance Number 134 be Amended by omitting from said section two of said ordinance number 134 the last paragraph which is as follows:

"Wholesale Trucks handling bread, meat, Vegetables and Merchandise, Five (\$5.00) Dollars per year."

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and posting as required by law, and the original ordinance number 134 shall in all other points remain in full force and effect.
