ORDINANCE NUMBER 142.

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton, in the Counties of Macoupin and Jersey, and State of Illinois.

SECTION ONE:

That there shall be smitted to the legal voter of said Village of Brighton at the annual election, to be held on April Twentieth A. D. 1937, the proposition:

"Shall the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton, in the Counties of Macoupin and Jersey, and State of Illinois levy a rate of not more than eight-seven and one-half (87 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hundredths of one per centum for general corporate purposes, which levy shall be made for a period of five years beginning in 1937."

SECTION TWO:

The Clerk shall cause the proposition herein made to be incorporated in the notices of election as posted by him as required by law, and shall cause the said proposition to be printed upon the ballots of said election in appropriate form.
