ORDINANCE NUMBER 144.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A LEVY OF TAXES FOR CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING THE FIRST DAY OF MAY A. D. 1938.

WHEREAS, there was duly passed at a regular meeting of the Village Board, of the Village of Brighton, held on the Fourth day of May, A. D. 1937, an Annual Appropriation Ordinance Number 143, which said Ordinance was duly signed and approved on the fourth day of May A. D. 1937, by the President and the Village Board of said Village, and published in the Carlinville Democrat, a weekly secular newspaper of general circulation, published in the City of Carlinville, Macoupin County, Illinois, making appropriation for corporate purposes, as follows: to-wit:

For electric lights on streets -----	\$ 1,000.00
For Officers' Salaries -----	300.00
For services of Village Marshall -----	500.00
For Streets, Alleys and Sidewalks -----	1,500.00
For expenses of Village Board of Health -----	50.00
For Maintenance of Village Fire Engine -----	150.00
For Election Expenses -----	150.00
For payment of Village Bonds and interest thereon --	650.00
Total -----	\$ 4,300.00

THEREFORE: Be it Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton, Counties of Macoupin and Jersey, State of Illinois, that there shall be assessed, levied and collected upon all real estate and personal property within the corporate limits of said Village of Brighton, Illinois, as the same appears from the regular assessed value thereof, to meet the appropriation

for corporate purposes heretofore mentioned, for the fiscal year ending on the first day of May . D. 1938, the sum of Four Thousand Three Hundred (\$4,300...) DOLLARS; that the several accounts levied and to be collected for each purpose are as follows:

For electric lights on streets -----	\$1,000.00
For Officers' Salaries -----	300...
For services of Village Marshall -----	500.00
For streets, alleys and Sidewalks -----	1,500.00
For expenses of Village Board of Health -----	500.00
For Maintenance of Village Fire Engine -----	150.00
For Election Expenses -----	150.00
For Payment of Village Bonds and interest thereon ----	650.00
Total -----	<u>\$4,300.00</u>

Any unexpanded balances remaining out of any of the aforementioned items may be paid out and expended in making up any deficit existing in any other item or items.

The Village Clerk of the Village of Brighton is hereby directed to make and file with the County Clerk of Macoupin County, and also with the County Clerk of Jersey County, immediately upon the passing of this Ordinance, a certified copy of this Ordinance, under the corporate seal of the Village of Brighton, Illinois, for the purpose of causing this levy to be extended on the tax books, as it is now required by law.

This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance Number 144 and shall be in force from and after its passage and approval.
