ORDINANCE # 148.

An Ordinance making appropriation for Corporate Purposes for the Fiscal year from the first day of May A. D. 1938, to the first day of May A. D. 1939

Be It Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton, In the Counties of Macoupin and Jersey in the State of Illinois.

Section One: That the following sums or so such thereof as may be authorized by law, be and the same are hereby appropriated for the said fiscal year beginning May first A. D. 1938:

For electric lights on streets -----	\$ 1,000.00
For Officer's Salaries -----	300.00
For Salary of Village Marshall -----	500...
For Streets, Alleys and Sidewalks -----	1,500.00
For Expxnses of Village Board of Health -----	50.00
For Maintenance of Village Fire Engine -----	150.00
For Election Expxnses -----	150...
For Payment of Village Bonds & interest thereon ---	650.00
Total -----	\$ 4,300.00

Section Two: All unexpended balances of any item or items of any general appropriation made by this Ordinance may be expended in making up any insufficiency in any items in the same general purpose or in like appropriation made by this Ordinance.
