ORDINANCE NUMBER 150

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 132 AND AMENDMENTS THERETO REGULATING THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS IN THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, COUNTIES OF MACOUPIN AND JERSEY, STATE OF ILLINOIS.

That Section Four (4) of Ordinance 132 shall be amended to read:

"Each said license shall terminate on the first day of May next following its issuance. The fee to be paid shall be reduced in proportion to the full calendar months, which have expired in the fiscal year prior to the issuance of the license. The annual fee for a license beginning on May first A. D. 1939 shall be Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, which shall authorize the retail sale only of alcoholic liquors on the premises described in the application and the license.

All fees shall be paid quarterly in advance, and in the event of the revocation or denial of the license, the pro-ratio share thereof shall be returned. All fees shall promptly be paid by the President of the Board of Trustees to the Village Treasurer."

It is further provided herein that the number of taverns or places where liquor shall be sold within the corporate limits of the Village shall be limited to one (1).

This Ordinance as revised shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days after its publication as provided by law.
