It was properly moved by Trustees Hermes seconded by Yancey that the Board adopt the resolution to designate Oak street from C. & A. R.R. to Burlington Railroad as an Arterial Street. Carried.

It was properly moved by Trustees Scheffel seconded by Gorin that resolution to deduct Plum St. Myrtle St. and Brown Street from Construction to Maintenance Section 2cs be accepted. Carried.

It was properly moved by Trustees Yancey seconded by Kuehnel that a resolution for improvement be Municipality under Motor Fuel Tax law of Oak St. Art. #9 from C. & A.R.R. to C.B. & Q. R.R. and Cross St. Art. #5 from Oak St. to Brown St. and Railroad. St.SA. #14 Washington to C.B. & Q.R.R. Crossing. Carried.

It was properly moved by Trustees Giller seconded by Scheffel that a resolution for Maintenance of Arterial Streets Vine St. to Main St. to S.A.#14, Brown St., Main St. to C.B. & Q. R.R. Spencer Road, Main St. to West Corp. limit. Spencer Road Main St. easterly 1/4 mile, County line Road. Arterial St. #1 South to Corp. limit. Carried.
