

Brighton, Ill.

July 2, 1945.

The President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton met on the above date at the Village Hall in regular session at 8'0'Clock.

Upon calling the roll the following were present: Pres. Chase; Trustee Scheffel; Trustee Gaither; Trustee Kuehnel; Trustee Giller; Treas. Bott and Clerk Warner. Absent Trustees Chas. Yancey and Milton Ziegenbein.

The minutes of the last regular meeting (June 4, 1945) and the called special meeting (June 27, 1945) were read and upon motion of Trustee Giller and a second by Gaither the minutes were accepted as read.

The Treasurer's report was read and showed a balance of \$178.73 in the General Fund and a balance of \$724.05 in the Motor Fuel Fund. Trustee Scheffel moved that the Treas. report be accepted as read, Trustee Gaither seconded the motion. Carried

ORDINANCE NO. 173

The Village Clerk read an ordinance entitled: "An Ordinance providing for the levy and assessment of taxes for the Village of Brighton, Illinois, for the current fiscal year from the 1st day of May, A. D. 1945 to the 1st day of May, A. D. 1946."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, ILLINOIS; 2

Section 1. That the sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred Ninety and no/100 Dollars (\$2,690.00), or so much thereof as may be allowed by law, be and the same is hereby levied and assessed on all of the real and personal property within the said Village subject to taxation, according to the valuation of said property as the same is assessed for the State and County purposes for the current fiscal year, an appropriation having been heretofore made for all corporate purposes of said village. The items of said appropriation and the apportionment of the amount levied appear in the columns below, as follows:

Trustee Giller thereupon moved that the said ordinance be finally passed as introduced and read. Trustee Kuehnel seconded the motion. The roll being called upon the question of the adoption of the motion that the ordinance be finally passed as read, the following vote was recorded:

Scheffel---Yes Gaither---Yes Kuehnel---Yes Giller--Yes

The President thereupon declared such motion carried and the ordinance finally passed as read and signed the said ordinance in approval thereof, and the ordinance was also signed by the Clerk and the corporate seal of said Village was affixed thereto.

Trustee Scheffel moved that the Village Board purchase (100 ft.) one hundred feet of one and one-half inch fire hose for the fire equipment. Kuehnel seconded the motion. The roll call vote on the above motion was as follows:

The President declared motion carried.

Being no further business to come before the board Trustee Giller moved that the meeting adjourn. Scheffel seconded the motion.
