

Nov. 5, 1945

The President and Village Board of Brighton met on the above date at the Village Hall at 7:00 P. M.

The Meeting was called to order by the President. The following answering the roll call: Pres. Chase, Trustee Giller, Trustee Scheffel, Trustee Yancey, Trustee Ziegenbein, Trustee Kuehnel, Treasurer H. G. Bott, and Clerk Paul L. Warner. Absent Trustee Gaither.

The minutes of the last regular meeting (Oct. 1, 1945) were read and were accepted as read by motion Trustee Ziegenbein and seconded by Trustee Scheffel.

The Treasurers' report was read and showed a balance of \$374.02 in the General Fund and a balance of \$76.34 in the Motor Fuel Fund. Ziegenbein moved that the report be accepted. Yancey seconded the motion. Report accepted.

Trustee Scheffel moved that the application be accept and the permit be granted. Trustee Yancey seconded the motion.

Trustee Ziegenbein, Trustee Yancey, & Trustee Giller were appointed by the President to make arrangements for the needed repairs of the roof and ceiling of the Village Hall.

Being no further business to come before the meeting Trustee Scheffel moved that the meeting adjourn. Trustee Ziegenbein seconded the motion.
