The report of the committee as to vacating the West end of South St. was given. Their recommendation was to sell each of the adjourning property owners, Mayerhoffer and Can 22ft. of the 49 ft. width of the street and the entire length of 135 ft. Thus leaving a 5 ft. walk for the people of the neighbor-hood to use. The price for the above strips of ground to be \$40.00 or \$20.00 for each adjoining property owner.

The report and recommendations of the committee was approved by a motion of Kuehnels and a second by Scheffel.
