

The Brighton Village Board met in Special session on the above date at the Village Hall. The meeting was called to order by the President Harold G. Bott with the following answering the roll call:

The purpose of the special meeting was the consideration of any action to be taken in regard to fire equipment to meet the specifications required by the Illinois Inspection Bureau. After a discussion on repair of the old fire equipment the following action was taken:

Anders moved St Cin seconded the motion that the Village advertise for bids on the following equipment:


1. To furnish Class A fire equipment to meet Illinois Bureau Class 8 rating, with midship pump of 500 G.P.M. or better to be mounted on chassis furnished by the undersigned in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Village Clerk. Said bids to take into account trade in value of present equipment.
2. To furnish 2 ton truck chassis, 4 speed transmission, to carry GVW of 18,000 lbs., with mud tires on rear. Chassis to be Chevrolet, Dodge, or International. Bids may be submitted on either or both of above propositions.

Further, bids will be received by the Village Clerk until February 4, 1957 at 8:00 P.M. with the Village of Brighton reserving the right to reject any and all bids.

Motion carried.

Being no further business to come before the meeting, Anders moved Oertel seconded the motion to adjourn.
