ORDINANCE # 231

AN ORDINANCE VACATING SHORT STREET, PART OF FREEMONT STREET, AN ALLEY RUNNING PARALLEL TO MARKET STREET BETWEEN FREEMONT STREET AND SHORT STREET AND AN ALLEY RUNNING IN A NORTHWESTERLY AND SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION AND BETWEEN LOTS 115 and 118 ON THE NORTH AND LOTS 116 and 117 ON THE SOUTH, ALL IN THE ORIGINAL PLAT OF THE TOWN, NOW VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, MACOUPIN COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

Oertel moved St Cin seconded the motion to suspend all rules of the Village Board which might prevent unless suspended the passage of said ordinance
