Dodge moved Powell seconded the motion to accept the bid of Havelka Co. to supply rock & oil for the Village streets. The reason for accepting said bid, which is approximatly \$260 higher then the lowest bid, is:

- 1. The inconvenience caused by the low bidders on oil being in Springfield and the low bidder on rock being in Godfrey. The question of getting the two together at the same time may present a problem.
- 2. The Havelka Co. would use a Buckeye Mechanical spreader for the rock, making a more uniform sealing surface. The same company spreading both the oil & rock would have much closer coordination on the job.
- 3. The low bidder on oil, Flatt Co. of Springfield, wants to bring a trailer load of oil, approximately 4000 gals, at a time and we would find it inconvenient to have enough street surface prepaired to use that amount at one time.
