ORDINANCE NO. 2022-04

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE REVISED CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, JERSEY AND MACOUPIN COUNTIES, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the Village of Brighton ("The Village") is an Illinois non-home rule municipality operating under the provisions of Article VII, Section 7, of the Illinois Constitution, and other laws; and

WHEREAS, The Village has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and that protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, JERSEY AND MACOUPIN COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION 1: Adoption of Revised Code. The following Exhibit "A" shall be the "**Revised Code of Ordinances**" of the Village of Brighton, Jersey and Macoupin Counties, Illinois" and shall be as follows:

SECTION 2: Severability of Provisions. Each section, paragraph, sentence, clause and provision of this Ordinance is severable, and if any provision is held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the remainder of the Ordinance, nor any part thereof, other than that part affected by such decision.

SECTION 3. Conflicting Ordinances. Any conflicting ordinances, code provisions or pertinent portions thereof in effect at the time this ordinance takes effect are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: Effective. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

SECTION 5: Adoption. Adopted this 7th day of March, 2022 by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton, Jersey and Macoupin Counties, Illinois, and deposited and filed in the office of the Village Clerk in said Village on that date.
