

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE
VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON
MACOUPIN AND JERSEY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

Title III, Chapter 31
Section 15

VILLAGE CLERK

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2024, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton adopted a new Code of Ordinance Book; and

WHEREAS, Section 31.15 states the Village Clerk shall be elected by the citizens of the Village of Brighton for a four-year term; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton have determined that it is advisable and in the best interests of the public and its welfare to appoint the position of the Village Clerk, rather than the Village Clerk being elected at large; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton passed 2024- 04, an Ordinance Authorizing the Appointment of the Village Clerk rather than an Election At Large, on June 3, 2024.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, MACOUPIN AND JERSEY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 31.15: Election; Term; Qualifications shall be amended, as follows:

APPOINTMENT; TERM; QUALIFICATIONS.

The Village Clerk shall be appointed by the Mayor, with approval of the Village Board of Trustees. The term of appointment shall be a four-year term, coinciding with the elected office of the Mayor. In the event there is a vacancy of the

office of Village Clerk, the new appointment of Village Clerk shall be for the remaining period of the original appointed four-year term.

Section 2. That the effective date of this Ordinance shall commence on May 5, 2025, which is the swearing in the of newly elected Mayor of the Village of Brighton, Illinois.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton.
