

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-06

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR MOBILE VENDING SERVICES
THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON MACOUPIN AND JERSEY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton have the authority to enact ordinances under 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton have determined it is necessary to establish operation procedures and requirements of mobile vending services provided to occur on public property or as a Village of Brighton sponsored event; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton have declared a mobile vending service includes, but is not limited to: food trucks, trailers, carts, and kiosks; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton acknowledge these types of mobile vending services are popular, and utilized by many in selling products in the Village of Brighton, and establishing a Rule of Order is necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRIGHTON, MACOUPIN AND JERSEY COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. Definitions

- A. Food Truck: Any self-contained motorized vehicle, or self-contained enclosed trailer with a valid license plate and registration, from which prepared food for immediate consumption is served.
- B. Kiosk: An impermanent or semi-permanent stand or structure intended to be located upon premises for the sale of prepared food and/or beverage products to the general public. The term shall include within its meaning the term "foodstand."
- C. Portable Vending Establishment: Any type of mobile vehicle or device, intended to be located upon premises for the sale of prepared food and/or beverage products to the general public.
- D. Vendor: A person engaged in the selling, or offering for sale, merchandise in any public place, from any structure named herein or otherwise described fully in a Mobile Vending Service application, or from his or her own person.

Section 2. Licensing/Permits

- A. The following directives only apply to those Mobile Vending Services which occur on public property or as a part of a Village of Brighton sponsored event.
- B. No mobile vending service shall engage in business operation on public property or as part of a Village of Brighton sponsored event without obtaining a permit from the Village of Brighton.
- C. Application for permits shall be obtained from the Village Clerk, who will forward said application to the appropriate committee for review and recommendation to the Village Board of Trustees.
- D. Applicants must provide a Certificate of Insurance at the time of application reflecting general public liability insurance, listing the Village of Brighton as an additional insured.
- E. Upon approval of issuance of the permit, the Village Clerk shall notify the State and County health departments of said operation.
- F. In the event the Village of Brighton receives notification of State and/or County health code violations, the Village of Brighton shall revoke said permit until all violations have been satisfied by the State and County health departments.
- G. The cost of a Mobile Vending Services Permit shall be \$50.00, unless the Mobile Vending Service is participating in a Village of Brighton sponsored event in which a different fee schedule for that limited function/event has been established.

Section 3. Operation of Services

- A. All food and/or beverage preparation in connection to or with the Mobile Vending Services operation shall be in accordance with the health and safety standards of the State of Illinois and Counties of Macoupin and Jersey, Illinois.
- B. Hours of Operation shall be from 6:00AM to 10:00PM, unless specifically stated otherwise on the mobile vending services permit.
- C. No alcoholic beverages shall be sold from a Mobile Vending Service unless the operator has obtained a liquor license from the Village of Brighton.

- D. Mobile Vending Service operators shall not operate within 100 feet from the front entrance of an existing business, unless:
1. Operation is part of a special event sponsored by the Village of Brighton, or
 2. The proprietor of the existing business has approved of the operation in writing, or
 3. The owner of the Mobile Vending Service is the same owner of the existing business.

Section 4. Enforcement and Penalties

- A. Any Mobile Vending Service permit holder who violates any provision of this ordinance or who violates any terms or conditions of any such permit shall be subject to revocation of said permit, without reimbursement of application fees and/or other costs associated with the issuance of said permit.
- B. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$250.00 per day, as well as any other relief allowed by Illinois State Law and Village of Brighton Ordinances.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Brighton.
